NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 NOVEMBER 2022

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2021**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st November 2022.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st November 2022 are as follows:
