



SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 JUNE 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 6) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st June 2023.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st June 2023 are as follows:

For June, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.4% while the Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 12.6%. The overall Energy Charges went down by 5.1% comparing to May and is due to reduction in Imported Fuel prices.
