



# SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

## NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 7) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st July 2023.

**Charges:** The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st July 2023 are as follows:

For July, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.3% while the Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.9%. The overall Energy Charges increased by 1.5% comparing to June and is due to increase in Imported Fuel prices.
