NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 AUGUST 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 8) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st August 2023.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st August 2023 are as follows:

For August, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.9% while the Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 3.7%. The overall Energy Charges decreased by 1.0% comparing to July and is due to decrease in Imported Fuel prices.
