NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 SEPTEMBER 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 9) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st September 2023.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st September 2023 are as follows:

For September, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.1% while the Fuel Charge increased by an average of 14.3%. The overall Energy Charges increased by 4.6% comparing to August and is due to increase in Imported Fuel prices.
