

SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 SEPTEMBER 2023

In accordance with the Electricity Act (Cap. 128) and the Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 9) Regulations 2023, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st September 2023.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st September 2023 are as follows:
