



SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 NOVEMBER 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 11) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st November 2023.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st November 2023 are as follows:

For November, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 1.0% while the Fuel Charge increased by an average of 13.2%. The overall Energy Charges increased by 5.5% comparing to October and is due to increase in Imported Fuel prices.
