



# SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

## NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 DECEMBER 2023

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) (No. 12) Regulations 2023**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st December 2023.

**Charges:** The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st December 2023 are as follows:

For December, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.4% while the Fuel Charge increased by an average of 8.0%. The overall Energy Charges increased by 4.1% comparing to November and is due to increase in Imported Fuel prices.
