NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 MARCH 2024

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2024**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st March 2024.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st March 2024 are as follows:

For March, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.7% while the Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 3.8%. The overall Energy Charges decreased by 1.1% comparing to February and is due to decrease in Imported Fuel prices.
