NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 APRIL 2024

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2024**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st April 2024.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st April 2024 are as follows:

For April, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.6% while the Fuel Charge increased by an average of 27.9%. The overall Energy Charges increased by 11.6% comparing to March and is due to increase in Imported Fuel prices.
