



SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 OCTOBER 2024

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2024**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st October 2024.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st October 2024 are as follows:
