



SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 DECEMBER 2024

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2024**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st December 2024.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st December 2024 are as follows:

For December, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.1% while Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 15.2% respectively. The overall Energy Charges decreased by 6.2% comparing to November and is due to decreases in Imported Fuel Prices and Foreign exchange rate (SBD/USD).
