



# SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

## NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 NOVEMBER 2024

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2024**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st November 2024.

**Charges:** The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st November 2024 are as follows:

For November, the Non Fuel Charge and Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.4% and 4.8% respectively. The overall Energy Charges decreased by 2.3% comparing to October and is due to decreases in Imported Fuel Prices and local Consumer Prices (CPI).
