NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st January 2025.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st January 2025 are as follows:
