## NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 FEBRUARY 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st February 2025.

**Charges:** The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st February 2025 are as follows:

For February, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.20% compared to January, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 3.4% respectively . The overall Energy Charges increased by 1.7% compared to January and is due to increase in Imported Fuel Prices.
