NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 MARCH 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st March 2025.

For March, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.7% compared to February, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 6.6% respectively. The overall Energy Charges increased by 3.4% compared to February and is due to increase in Imported Fuel Prices.
