



# SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

## NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 APRIL 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st April 2025.

**Charges:** The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st April 2025 are as follows:

For April, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.6% compared to March, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 18.5% respectively. The overall Energy Charges increased by 8.4% compared to March and is due to increase in Imported Fuel Prices.
