NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 MAY 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st May 2025.

For May, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.2% compared to April, while Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 9.1% respectively. The overall Energy Charges decreased by 4.6% compared to April and is due to decrease in Imported Fuel Prices.
