NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2025

In accordance with the Electricity Act (Cap. 128) and the Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st July 2025.
