NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st July 2025.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st July 2025 are as follows:

For July, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 1.01% compared to June, while Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 10.4% respectively . The overall Energy Charges as compared to June decreased by 6.5% due to decrease in Imported fuel prices.
