

SIEA TRADING AS SOLOMON POWER

NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 AUGUST 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st August 2025.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st August 2025 are as follows:

For August, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.6% compared to July, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 3.2% respectively. The overall Energy Charges as compared to July increased by 1.7% due to increase in Foreign Exchange rate (SBD/USD) and overseas Producer Price Indexes (PPI) compared to their base months.
