NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 OCTOBER 2025

In accordance with the **Electricity Act (Cap. 128)** and the **Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025**, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st October 2025.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st October 2025 are as follows:

For October, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.76% compared to September, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 8.9% respectively. The overall Energy Charges as compared to September increased by 3.6% due to increase in Imported fuel prices.
