NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 February 2026

In accordance with the Electricity Act (Cap. 128) and the Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st February 2026.

Charges: The rates of charges payable for the supply of electricity on and from 1st February 2026 are as follows:

For February, the Non Fuel Charge and Fuel Charge increased by an average of 0.8% and 5% respectively compared to January. The overall Energy Charges as compared to January increased by 2.7% due to increase in Imported fuel prices.
