NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 June 2026

In accordance with the Electricity Act (Cap. 128) and the Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st June

For June, the Non Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 0.4% compared to May, while Fuel Charge increased by an average of 68.2% respectively . The overall Energy Charges as compared to May increased by 31.2% due to increase in Imported fuel prices.
