NEW CHARGES FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE 1 September 2026

In accordance with the Electricity Act (Cap. 128) and the Electricity (Charges for Supply) Regulations 2025, the electricity tariffs have been reviewed and new rates of charges for the supply of electricity take effect on 1st

For September, the Non Fuel Charge increased by an average of 2.05% compared to August, while Fuel Charge decreased by an average of 32.37% respectively . The Overall Energy Charges as compared to August decreased by 18.3% due to lower imported fuel costs and the impact of government fuel tax exemptions.
